Sheep Scramble Rules

1. Entry Fee is \$10.00 per child.
2. Sheep Scramble is for children 8 - 14 years of age.
3. Release form must be filled out completely and signed by parent or guardian.
4. Shoes or boots must be worn while participating. No flip flops or sandals.
5. Check in starts at 5:00 pm at the grandstands. Children will receive their shirts at this time.
6. Participants will be given a rope halter before entering the arena.
7. At NO time can the rope halter be used as a lariat.
8. At NO time can the participants tie the rope halter to any part of their body.
9. If participant has hold of the Lamb, NO other participant will be allowed to touch the Lamb until it breaks away.
10. If two or more participants catch the same Lamb, the Lamb will be turned loose.
11. Participant must secure and properly halter the Lamb.
12. A winner will be indicated by Beagle Boy Referees.
13. No undue roughness or poor sportsmanship will be tolerated.
